## SENIOR SCHOOL

**Only official school uniform is to be worn and these items are only available from the Uniform Shop unless otherwise specified.**

### WINTER UNIFORM

School navy raincoat OR navy overcoat OR waterproof cagoule

School navy blazer

School navy kilt (sensible length ie. at or just below the knee)

School navy blue pullover

School blue striped blouse

School navy 'turn over top' short socks or 70 denier navy tights

Black shoes\* (heel limit is 4cms) please see diagram on following page

School scarf for Years 7 – 9 (Years 10/11 may wear plain navy scarf\*)

School dark blue overall for Science/Art (name to be embroidered in yellow – see below for details)

### SUMMER UNIFORM (this can be worn between the start of the Summer Term and the October half term)

School kilt, shoes and pullover – same as above

School blue striped short sleeve blouse

Neutral tights may be worn in place of navy tights

### GAMES UNIFORM

School navy games skirt and shirt

School navy games socks – winter

School white games socks – summer

Plain navy tracksuit trousers

Navy 'hoodie' School sweatshirt

Games bag

Predominately white trainers\*

Tennis racquet\*

Tennis whites – **teams only**

Hockey shin pads

Hockey stick\*

Navy cycling shorts

\* Not available in Uniform Shop

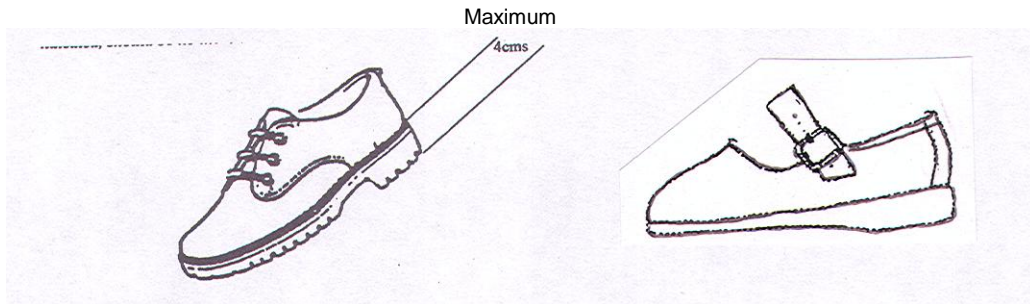


Body piercing other than pierced ears is not acceptable.

If below collar length, hair **MUST** be worn tied back with a **navy** hair ribbon or scrunchy.

### SHOE INFORMATION

For health and safety reasons we expect all the girls to wear shoes which conform to the uniform code. Girls may NOT wear flimsy slip-on shoes, shoes with open heels/toes or shoes with 'high heels' or patent leather shoes.



If you have any doubt, please do contact the School for advice.

**Shoes should offer sufficient support for the foot and be robust enough to be worn 5 days a week.**

Note – high fashion shoes are rarely suitable, if in doubt seek clarification from school eg. the current ballet pump style is not suitable.

**NEW UNIFORM** is obtained only from our own **UNIFORM SHOP** situated in Croft. The opening times during term are:

**SECOND HAND UNIFORM SHOP** – the organisation of this service is now undertaken by Mrs R. Steedman and incorporated within the Uniform Shop.

Uniform, in nearly new condition, is always in great demand. Items to be sold **MUST BE LAUNDERED/DRY CLEANED**, marked clearly with the name, address and telephone number of the owner and brought to the school at any time during shop hours.

35% of the selling price goes into the Old Girls' Bursary Fund which is used to provide bursaries to assist pupils if family circumstances change. Should any item be intended as a gift to the school, please mark the label with a large cross.

Sports equipment such as riding clothes are acceptable but **NOT** riding hats. No shoes please except hockey boots and riding boots.

Please note – we are unable to exchange second-hand uniform once purchased from the shop. It can however be resold by you, as the parent, via the shop, but payment won't be made until goods are resold.
