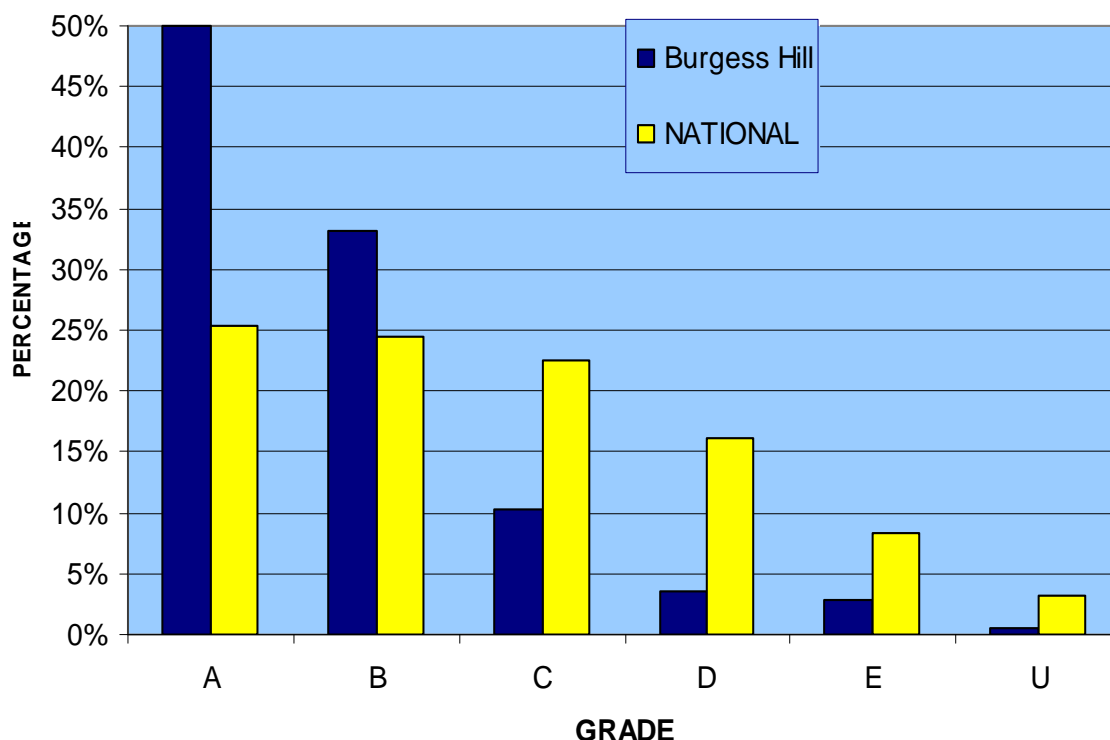


82.4% of all entries gained A or B grades and a stunning 92.5% of all grades were A, B or C. 16 students gained 3 or more A grades and a total of 32 achieved all A and B grades. Over the last 5 years our Upper Sixth Year Students have averaged 83% A and B grades demonstrating a level of consistency that cannot be matched by any other school in Sussex. It is this level of top grade success that continues to allow the vast majority of our students to secure places on their chosen courses at their preferred universities.

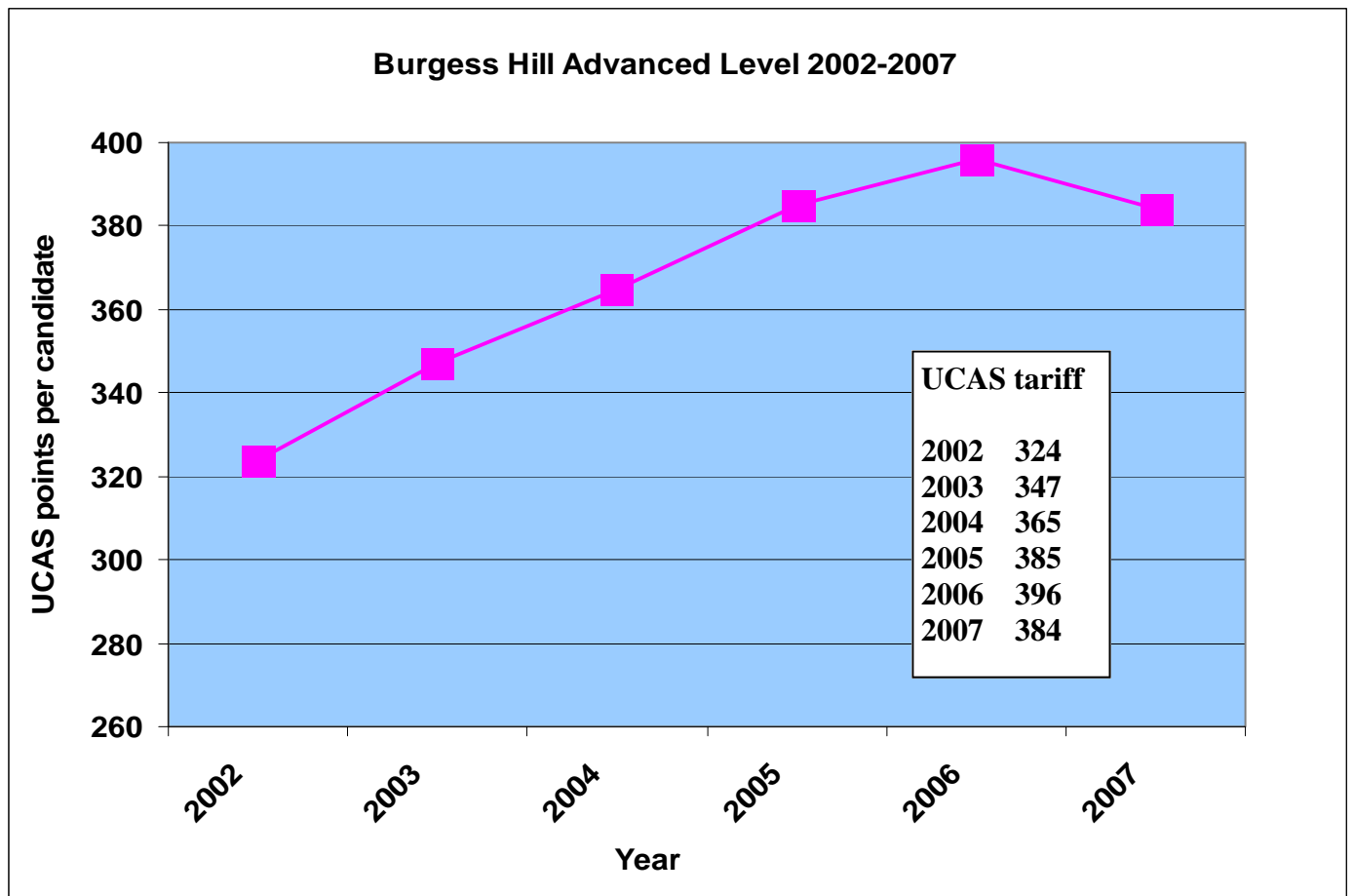

Last year we celebrated a set of GCSE results that has broke all records for both Burgess Hill School and all schools in Sussex. **Our 2007 Year Group has lived up to the challenge and delivered a stunning 76% A* and A grades to again top the Sussex Tables by a very wide margin.**

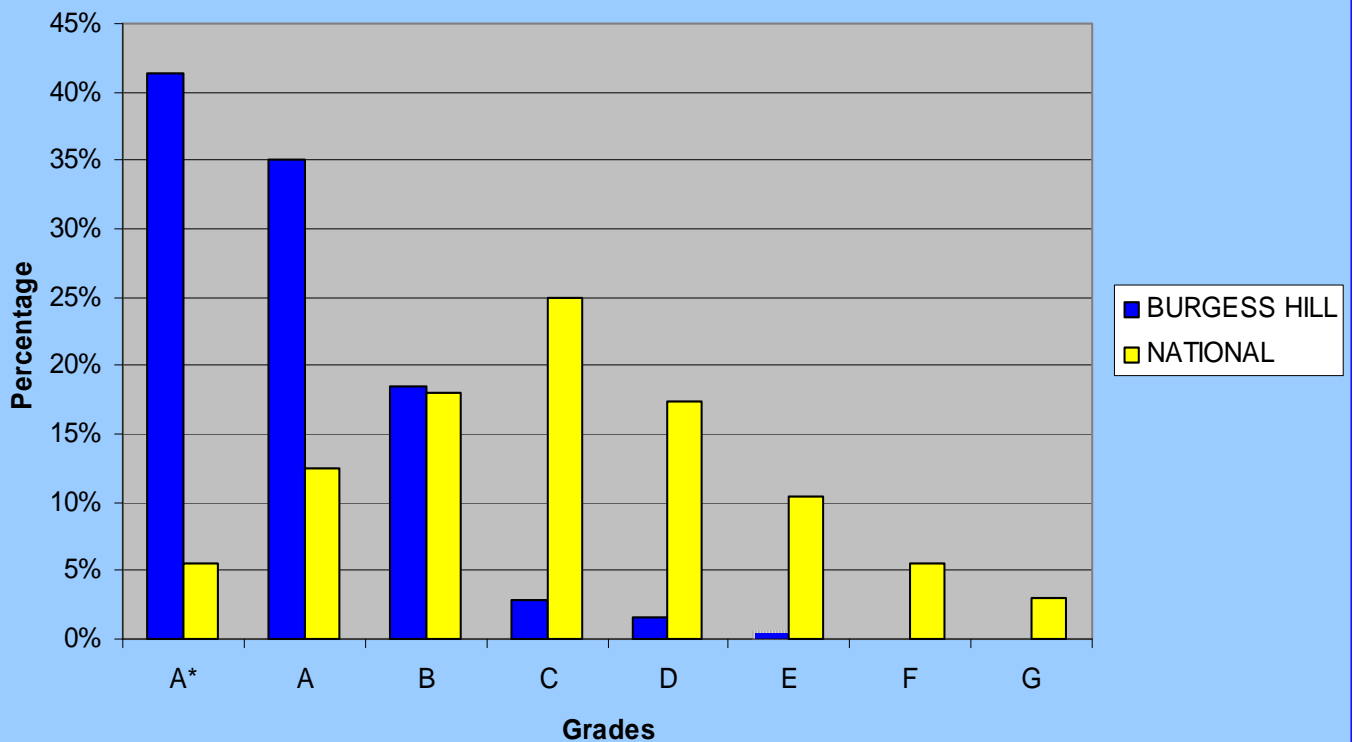
This is an outstanding achievement given the fact that the majority of top 100 schools are considerably more selective than we are.

50 girls included 6 or more passes at A* or A grade representing an amazing 75% of the year group.

Sophie Brammer (English and French), Holly Miller (French and Spanish), Kirsty Simons (French and Spanish), Alexandra Vermes (French), Molly Horton (French), Helena Osborne (French), Moira Ryan (Spanish) all achieved one of the top five marks in the UK. (100,997 candidates in French and 35412 in Spanish) This is an unprecedented event, and, with the outstanding achievement of the whole year group in Science, demonstrates the impressive breadth of achievement of our Year 11 students against the concern being expressed nationally about the quality of performance and popularity of these subject areas.

21 Burgess Hill students have achieved "top five" marks in the UK at GCSE in the last six years.
