Sixth Form Scholarships for entry in 2012

Sixth Form Academic, Music, Art, Drama, Sport and Technology Scholarships are available to internal and external candidates of excellent academic standard based on written examinations and/or practical assessment and interview. For entry in September 2012, these examinations will take place on Thursday 3rd and Saturday 5th November 2011, applicants will be required to attend both days.

Scholarships are worth up to a maximum of half of the day tuition fees.

The majority of scholarships awarded are in the range of 10%-25% day fees. The value of a single or accumulation of awards shall not exceed half the day fees.

All Scholars are expected to act as ambassadors and give their full support to the relevant curricular and extra-curricular areas. In particular, Music Scholars are expected to support the Music department and give service to the choirs and orchestras, Sports Scholars are expected to play an active role in the sporting life of the School and Drama Scholars are expected to support the Head of Drama with clubs and productions. Technology, Art and Drama Scholars would normally study the relevant subject to A level.

Academic Scholarships

Candidates are assessed by examinations in two subjects of their choice and a General Scholarship Paper. The papers are designed to measure potential and skills rather than acquired knowledge. Heads of Departments will be delighted to discuss the style and content of examination papers with prospective candidates.

Academic Scholarship candidates may also enter for one or more of the Creative Scholarships.

Short-listed candidates will be invited for interview.

Creative Scholarships

Creative Scholarships reflect a very high degree of aptitude in one of the following disciplines: Music, Art, Sport, Drama and Technology.

Details of the assessment procedures may be obtained from the School and may include: audition, interview, practical assessment or the production of a portfolio. Candidates will also sit a General Scholarship Paper. Short-listed candidates will be invited for interview.

Bursaries

Means-tested bursaries may be available for students whose parents feel that they would benefit from the opportunities that our Sixth Form offers but who cannot afford full fees. Bursary values range upwards from 10%. A limited number of full fee bursaries are available. Further information can be requested from the Bursar.
